

Travel by rail on the Overland, Indian Pacific and XPT, between three capital cities. Enjoy free time to explore Adelaide and Sydney, including a full day tour to the famous Barossa wine region, and a dinner cruise on Sydney Harbour.

DEPARTS EVERY FRIDAY - 9 DAYS / 8 NIGHTS

Friday: Board the Overland for your departure to Adelaide. Settle into your Premium Service seat and enjoy the rolling views, arriving into Adelaide late this afternoon. *Overnight: Majestic Roof Garden Hotel or similar, 4 nights (BL)*

Saturday: Today is a free day to explore Adelaide at your leisure.

Sunday: Travel to the Barossa and taste award-winning wines and enjoy morning tea at Pindarie Wine Estate. Then it's on to Maggie Beer's Farm Shop, where you will hear all about Maggie's story. There's more wine tastings and a gourmet lunch at Lambert Estate, before finishing the day at Barossa Valley Chocolate Company, to enjoy a chocolate and wine pairing. *(L)*

Monday: Today discover McLaren Vale, including tour, tastings and lunch at the spectacular d'Arenberg Cube. There's another tour and tastings at Wirra Wirra, and an option of either wine, gin or beer tastings at Beresford Wines. Finish your day with free time to explore the main street. *(L)*

Tuesday: Today depart Adelaide on the Indian Pacific. At Broken Hill, choose to see the magnificent Drag Queens performing at the Palace Hotel. Or if local art is more your thing, you may like to visit Broken Hill's Regional Art Gallery, or the much loved "Big Picture", housed in the Silver City Mint and Art Centre. *Overnight: Indian Pacific (LD)*

Wednesday: This morning enjoy an off

train excursion into the World Heritage Listed Blue Mountains, and see the spectacular Jamison Valley and iconic Three Sisters. A light lunch at The Lookout Restaurant is included, before continuing your rail journey to Central Station. Alternatively you may prefer to travel straight through to Sydney. On arrival in Sydney, make your own way to your accommodation. *Overnight: Rendezvous Hotel Sydney Central or similar, 3 nights (B)*

Thursday: This evening enjoy Sydney Harbour's signature dinner cruise aboard the MV Sydney 2000. Feast on a 3 course contemporary Australian a la carte menu, with the lights of Sydney as your spectacular backdrop. Live music and dancing will keep you entertained as you cruise for 3.5 hours around the Harbour. (D)

Friday: Today travel around Sydney Harbour using your Hop On Hop Off Explorer pass. Departing from Circular Quay or Darling Harbour, you can visit such places as Taronga Zoo, Manly, Watsons Bay, Luna Park, Shark Island or Barangaroo. Entry fees to some of these locations is an additional cost.

Saturday: This morning depart Sydney on the XPT, and travel first class to Melbourne. Early evening you will arrive at Southern Cross Station, having finished your rail adventure.
