Sunday: This morning, take a river cruise downstream to Fremantle where you will enjoy a tram tour taking in the key sights of the port city. You will be collected and transferred to Barrack Street Jetty to join your ferry to Rottnest Island. Tuesday: Cruise upstream on the Swan River to Swan Valley. When you arrive, you will be welcomed at Sandalford Estate and taken on an exclusive tour of the winery, followed by wine tastings and a delicious two course lunch.
