Itinerary & Inclusions

Day One: Lunch, Dinner

Meet Tour Escort, Shirley Tamm, at your city hotel or the Adelaide Central Bus Station. Travel to Cape Jervis to board the SeaLink Ferry to Penneshaw, Kangaroo Island. On arrival, visit Frenchman's Rock and the Maritime & Folk Museum before lunch at the Penneshaw Hotel. Continue to Cape Willoughby, where the first lighthouse built in SA is located. Accommodation for the next five nights is at the delightful Mercure Kangaroo Island Lodge, American River. Enjoy dinner this evening with your fellow travellers.

Day Two: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Head to the north of the island to the Old Wisanger School, officially opened in 1885, then to the 'secret beach' at Stokes Bay. Our delicious lunch today will be enjoyed at the Rockpool Café, Stokes Bay. This afternoon visit the Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park with its amazing array of animals, then some wine tasting at the picturesque Bay of Shoals Winery before returning to our hotel and enjoying dinner with our group.

Day Three: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Today we visit famous Seal Bay for a guided beach walk amongst a colony of Australian sea lions. Then its onto Raptor Domain for their entertaining Birds of Prey presentation. Lunch is at Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery Café and then we call into Island Beehive for honey tastings and a chance to shop! We return to our hotel for dinner.

Day Four: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Tour the township of Kingscote with free time to explore and shop before lunch at Café Scrumptious. Then it is on to the western end of the Island to Flinders Chase National Park to witness its natural rugged beauty and the spectacular Remarkable Rocks, Cape du Couedic Lighthouse and Admirals Arch. Tonight, we enjoy dinner at the Hotel.

Day Five: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Visit Clifford's Honey Farm, home to the only pure strain of Ligurian Bee in the world followed by a delicious lunch at the Emu Bay Lavender Farm with time to browse and shop in their charming store. We stop off at Emu Bay, renowned for its beautiful 4-kilometre beach. Lastly, we visit the award-winning KI Spirits for gin tasting before our farewell group dinner at the hotel.

Day Six: Breakfast, Lunch

Departing American River, we head back to Penneshaw stopping at KI Artworks Gallery to pick up last-minute gifts and then we have fun at Rob's Shearing and Sheepdogs demonstration before lunch at Dudley Wines Cellar Door with its spectacular views over Backstairs Passage - a perfect end to a wonderful six days. We return to Adelaide this afternoon via the SeaLink ferry and a picturesque drive through the Fleurieu Peninsula reminiscing about wonderful new friendships and great memories of Kangaroo Island.
