

STATEROOMS




OUTSIDE CABINS


Our 45 outside cabins are located on the Randell and Cadell Decks. The majority of these cabins have twin beds; a limited number of double bed cabins are also available. Each outside cabin opens onto the outside deck walkway and feature picture windows to view the passing scenery.

INSIDE CABINS

Our 9 inside cabins are located on the lower Chaffey Deck and open onto a wide inside passageway. Inside cabins offer twin beds; a limited number of double bed cabins are also available. Each inside cabin has a small porthole high in the ensuite facing the outside. Note: inside cabins are only accessible by stairs.











