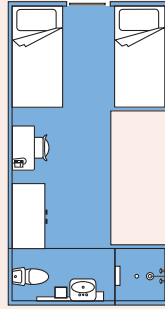
STATEROOMS

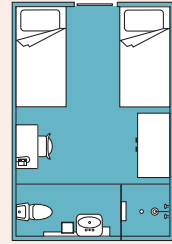
OUTSIDE CABINS

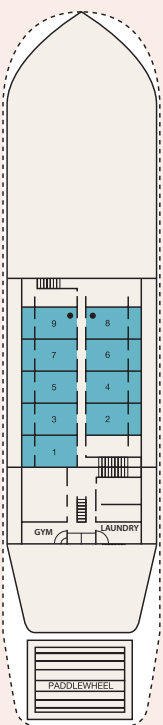


INSIDE CABINS

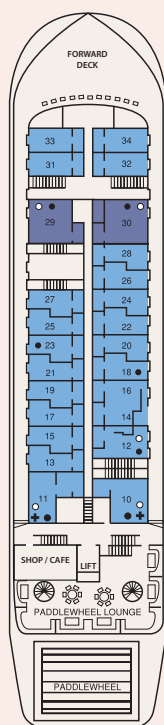
