## Commitment to Community

At SeaLink SEQ, we have a deep connection to the North Stradbroke Island (Minjerribah) and Southern Moreton Bay Islands (SMBI) communities.

These islands are more than just places to visit. They are vibrant communities and homes for many, including our staff, who live and work here, raise families, and contribute to the local way of life.

For more than 60 years, we have proudly supported these communities, investing in local organisations, sporting clubs, events, environmental initiatives, and education programs. Through in-kind travel support and meaningful partnerships, we remain committed to fostering prosperity, sustainability, and community spirit on the islands.

As the region grows, so does our commitment to helping these communities thrive. To ensure we provide support in a fair and strategic way, we have introduced a structured sponsorship program with two application windows per year. This helps us review applications holistically, maximise the impact of our sponsorships, and manage our budget effectively – all while continuing to back the communities we care about.



## Sponsorship Categories

Our sponsorships are guided by three key Community Investment Focus Areas, reflecting our commitment to sustainability and long-term community growth:

#### Community Impact

Supporting grassroots initiatives that bring people together and strengthen local connections. For example, sporting clubs, cultural festivals, and community groups.

#### Health & Wellbeing

Encouraging initiatives that promote healthy lifestyles and overall wellbeing. For example, youth programs, community meal services, and active lifestyle events.

#### **Environment & Education**

Supporting projects that protect the environment and enhance learning opportunities. For example, conservation projects, sustainable tourism initiatives, and educational programs. A dedicated budget is allocated to each category per financial year, ensuring support is spread fairly and effectively.







## Who Can Apply?

#### To be eligible for sponsorship, applicants must:

Be based in the Redlands Coast, with a strong preference for NSI or SMBI organisations.

Align with one or more of the three Community Investment Focus Areas.

Provide clear benefits to the local community.

Offer tangible recognition for SeaLink SEQ (e.g., branding, PR, social media exposure, event presence).

Submit applications within the designated timeframes.

#### **Exclusions**

Unfortunately we are unable to provide sponsorship for:

Religious organisations for religious activities.

Ongoing operational costs (e.g., staff wages, admin expenses).

Events promoting irresponsible alcohol consumption or gambling.

Activities that harm the environment.

Requests from individuals.

Initiatives that conflict with SeaLink SEQ policies or create financial dependency.



## **Application Process**

Application Windows: Open twice a year in July and January (subject to

change).

Submission Format: Applicants must complete an online application form

outlining their initiative, requested support, and how

they will recognise SeaLink SEQ.

**Review Process:** Applications are carefully reviewed to ensure alignment

with our community focus areas and business

objectives.

Decision Notification: Applicants will be notified within four weeks after

applications close.

**Exceptions:** Requests outside the set application periods may be

considered in extraordinary circumstances, particularly

for projects with significant community benefits.

#### 2025

1 July: Applications open
31 July: Applications close
1 August: Applications are reviewed with notification occurring within 4 weeks

#### 2026

12 January: Applications open
8 February: Applications close

9 February: Applications are reviewed with notification occurring within 4 weeks
